Please be reassured thatchildren will be asked to stay in the shade during breaktimes and encouraged to drink regularly throughout the day with water bottles refilled as needed.


Please ensure your child brings to school a named sunhat and water bottle each day.

In addition, please ensure sun cream has been applied in the morning **before** school.

If you would like to send your child in with sun cream to reapply during the day, their name <u>must</u> be on the bottle and this <u>must</u> be handed to their class teacher as they arrive in the morning.

No sun cream will be shared between children. All children will need to be able to reapply their sun cream independently. Staff are unable to apply sun cream to children. Roll-on sun cream bottles are available in most stores that may assist in your child being independent with this task.

With ongoing conversations about children's use of smartphones and social media, and the impact these

can have on their wellbeing, many families in our community are choosing to support the pact. The initiative encourages us to work together to delay giving children smartphones, helping to keep them safe and allowing them to enjoy childhood with fewer digital pressures.

As a school, we want to emphasise the importance of reducing children's reliance on smartphones. We believe this has long-term benefits, fostering face-to-face connections, encouraging creativity, and supporting a healthier, more engaged childhood.

Our current school policy is that children do **not** bring mobile phones to school, unless prior arrangements have been made with the school.
