Worship Club and Easter Service/Eucharist



Every Thursday, a team of Bishop Luffa students come over to Rumboldswhyke to lead worship. This usually involves lots of singing, dancing and acting out stories from the Bible. Our children always look forward to Thursday worship and are inspired by the Bishop Luffa team, often pleading to take a leading role themselves.

Fr. Angus and I would like to set up our own Rumboldswhyke Team who will help put together our Easter Service/Eucharist, which will take place in St. George's Church at 2pm on Thursday 30th March. The whole school will be involved in the service and

School Uniform and Equipment

To ensure your children make the best possible progress it is vitally important that they have their book bags in school every day. It is also important that children wear appropriate footwear in accordance to the uniform policy.

- Footwear: Black comfortable shoes. Not trainers or <u>boots</u> Open toed and slip on sandals or shoes with heels are not appropriate footwear for school.
- Black / white plimsolls or trainers for P.E. fashion trainers are not permitted.

A number of children are coming to school without a change of shoes for P.E. and are wearing boots to school. Wearing boots for physical activities is unsafe! If you are having difficulty finding appropriate shoes/ plimsols please pop in and let me know.
