Dear Rumboldswhyke families,

Well here we are, at the end of the first half of the Summer term and we are blessed with the arrival of the sunshine. This is set to continue next week so I hope you are able to make the most of it!

The Summer term is always an incredibly busy month in schools. Below are some important events, and names and dates of assessments taking place. They are nothing to be concerned about and we do not advocate placing pressure on children. They will barely know the assessments are happening. We would ask that you continue to support your child as you have all year: listening to them read, reading to them, practising key words and sounds, and practising their times tables (KS2).

Phonics Screening Check- w/b 12th June: This is undertaken by children in year 1 and children in year 2 who did not meet the standard last year or did not take the test. This is a statutory check that all children need to do as set out by the government.

Multiplication check – between 5th-23rd June: This is undertaken by children in Year 4. It is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12. It is an onscreen check of 25 questions. This is a statutory check that all children need to do as set out by the government. Further information can be found here:

NFER standardised tests – during June. These standardised tests are taken by children in Year 3 and 4. These are non-statutory (they are school based assessments). They consist of a Reading test and 3 Maths tests: 1 arithmetic (pure calculations) and 2 problem solving and reasoning tests where questions are put into a context for the children to solve. The assessments inform our future planning and enable us to track current attainment levels and progress.

Schools have a statutory responsibility to promote the benefits of good attendance and have a clear school attendance policy. Our attendance policy has been produced in collaboration with other Chichester schools. At our recent governing body meeting we reviewed (and approved) this policy to ensure it clearly sets out our expectations of the school and parents.
