Staffing for September 2023

You will notice that some of our Year 1 cohort will be in Blue Class and some will be in Yellow class. Let me reassure you that we are very experienced in teaching mixed age classes. The children will receive a Year 1 curriculum regardless of the class they are in. If you would like further information on how we manage this, please pop in to talk to us.

To prepare the children for next year, we have organised some transition sessions. Both Mr Wilson and Mr Dickin are currently teaching in other schools, therefore arranging a convenient day for them both to join us is rather tricky.

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Midday Meals Supervisor Vacancy



Parking in Rumbolds Close

<u>Parking in the close is Permit ONLY</u> and may result in your receiving a fine (even in a marked parking space). Traffic Wardens do visit during school drop off and pick ups, so unless you have a permit, you should not park here.

No one should park over anyone's driveway and the hatched area in front of the school gate must be kept clear at ALL times. This is to allow emergency vehicles to enter the school if necessary. Limited parking is available in St George's church for those who wish to drive.
