School Uniform Policy

Last week, our governors reviewed our School Uniform Policy. We felt it is important to ensure our uniform was smart, affordable and complied with Health and Safety and Equality regulations. Therefore, we have made the following amendments:

- Removal of girls/boys' uniform section
- P.E. section to state children wear their P.E. kit on P.E. days and this includes black tracksuits or plain black leggings in cold weather
- Earrings should be removed for <u>ALL</u>
 P.E./swimming lessons. Children should come to school with earrings removed on P.E. days or they must be able to remove them themselves before the P.E. lesson. Staff are not allowed to remove earrings for children.

Please read the attached uniform policy to ensure your child is wearing the correct kit. This policy comes into effect from the1st January 2024.
