#### School Uniform

Just a reminder our updated school uniform policy comes into effect at the beginning of next term. Some of the main amendments made were:

- Removal of girls/boys' uniform section
- P.E. section to state children wear their P.E. kit on P.E. days and this includes <u>black</u> tracksuits or plain <u>black</u> leggings in cold weather

Earrings should be removed for <u>ALL</u>
P.E./swimming lessons. Children should come to school with earrings removed on P.E. days or they must be able to remove them themselves before the P.E. lesson. Staff are not allowed to remove earrings for children.

**Please can parents ensure all children are dressed for school in line with our policy** (please see attachment for full details).

#### Swimming / PE / Forest School for next term:

Please find below the PE, Forest School and Swimming timetable for this half term.

On Tuesdays, Red Class will be continuing with their swimming lessons and may come to school in their PE kits on this day and bring their swimming costume etc with them in a named bag.
