


# Newsletter 26th January 2024

### Home Start Chichester and District

Home-Start Chichester & District offer 'Stay and Play' Family Groups across the district.

For over 15 years they have worked with families who have at least one pre-school child in the home who are finding parenting difficult; this may be due to disability, mental health, anxiety, isolation, or poverty.

## Wraparound Childcare Survey

The national wraparound childcare programme is part of the childcare reforms announced at the 2023 Spring Budget. The government's ambition is that by 2026, all parents and carers of primary school-aged children who need it will be able to access term time childcare in their local area from 8:00 to 18:00, so that parents can access employment and improve labour market participation. As part of this reform West Sussex Services for Schools are running a parent survey to better understand what the current and future childcare need might be. # Tax Free Childcare (TFC)

Tax-Free Childcare (TFC) is a childcare top-up for working parents. It can be used to help pay for accredited holiday clubs, childminders, or sports activities. TFC enables parents and carers to access childcare during the school holidays,



saving them money. It is estimated that there are 1.3 million working families who are eligible for TFC in the UK, however only a small percentage are making use of the scheme. Around **75% of families are losing out** on this support.

TFC is available for children aged up to 11, or 17 if the child has a disability. Please visit <u>Childcare</u> <u>Choices</u>, to see if you are eligible. You can find out more about the scheme <u>here</u>.

Many parents don't realise that TFC can be saved up on their accounts. Even if childcare is not required throughout the school terms, there is still the option to save up funds which could be used for holiday clubs or out of school care.
