<u>Parking</u>

Last week, I contacted you regarding parking in Rumbolds Close. Thank you so much for your efforts to park on nearby roads, I have really noticed a difference. I know this is not an easy thing to do as many of the roads are 'permit parking only'. I have been in touch with the Parking Services Manager at Chichester District Council who has informed me that there is free unrestricted parking in York Road and along Whyke Road (on the Quarry Lane side of the train gates). Free unrestricted parking is marked grey on the map below. There is no need for parents to park in contravention/illegally on yellow line restrictions (red and blue on the map) or the school zig zags (yellow section on the map).

The Parking Manager also advised me that:

'Some years ago it was agreed that due to the location of the school being a considerable distance from CDCs car parks, parents were permitted to park in the F permit holders only resident bays in the surrounding roads to the school at drop off and pick

up times for a maximum of 20 minutes. (marked green on the map)'

However, I have asked for this to be confirmed officially in writing, as last year I know a parent was issued with a parking ticket for stopping in a marked bay in Rumbolds Close. Once I have received a reply I will duly advise you.
