
Pancake Party - 17 February

Chicken Pox

As you may be aware, we now have a number of cases of chicken pox throughout the school in various classes.

Chickenpox is a common childhood illness and is usually mild; however, it is highly infectious. We ask that you remain vigilant and monitor your child for symptoms, which may include a fever, feeling unwell, and an itchy rash that develops into fluid-filled blisters.

If your child develops symptoms of chickenpox, please keep them at home and inform the school office. Children should remain off school until all blisters have crusted over, which usually takes around five days.
