Protecting Young People from Radicalisation:

West Sussex County Council have started a new project aimed at educating parents and carers on the dangers of online radicalisation. They are working with a specialist training company, Small Steps, to deliver a training project directly to parents and carers to support them in identifying and challenging online extremist ideologies and narratives.


These one hour online webinars will explore:



- What factors can make young people susceptible to extremist ideas
- How to support others and where to get help
- Understand the dangers of certain platforms used by extremists
- What disinformation and misinformation are and the dangers of both
- Signs of radicalisation, how to have difficult conversations and what to do if approached by an extremist online
- Interactive gaming activities that showcase strategies used by extremists on virtual platforms

Wraparound childcare survey:

West Sussex County Council's Early Years and Childcare team has launched a new survey to understand families' experiences of wraparound childcare. Wraparound childcare provides families with care for school aged children before and after the school day.

The survey is open to all families with primary school-aged children, whether they currently use wraparound childcare in West Sussex or not. It asks about what is working well, what could be improved, and how childcare outside of the school day can better meet the needs of local families.

The survey is anonymous, and your feedback will contribute to countywide planning and development. The deadline to complete the survey is **23:59 on Sunday 22nd February**.
