What a busy week last week was! As you will now be aware, we were officially re-opened on 1st October as part of the Bishop Luffa Learning Partnership. On Friday afternoon, we welcomed Chichester MP, Gillian Keegan, alongside Austen Hindman, the Partnership CEO with two Bishop Luffa School captains to an outside formal opening event.



Last week, the advertisement for a new Head of School for Rumboldswyke also went live. This will be a fantastic opportunity for someone new to come in and play a key role in helping grow the school, alongside the existing staff. We will keep you updated with how our search is going in a few weeks' time.

This week and next, we will be working with Bishop Luffa who are creating a 'virtual tour' of the school for prospective families who cannot visit face to face at the moment due to current restrictions. We will let you know when that goes live- please do make sure you share it widely for us!

Finally, you may have seen that the Government have placed a statutory duty on schools to have a Remote Learning Policy in place. This is in case of further lockdowns, or increasing numbers of families who may have to self-isolate. We have decided that we will continue to use Tapestry (Year R and 1) and Seesaw (Year 2) as our learning platforms for home and for any home learning while children are in school.
