Proposal

- Rumboldswhyke would become an all-through primary school.
- Rumboldswhyke's PAN (Pupil Admission Number for each year group) would be reduced from 40 to 18.
- The change would be gradual and only involve students already in the school. Students
 presently in Year 2 would be allowed to continue into Year 3. We believe that there are
 enough students in the area to sustain a school primary without adversely affecting
 neighbouring schools.
- We would be aiming to have a full primary school by September 2024.

The closing date is 16th December 2020.
