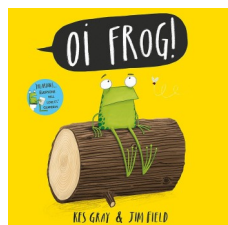
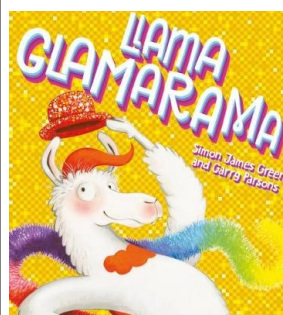


Book and Author Highlights

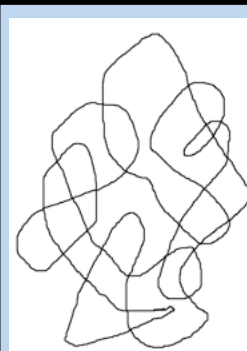

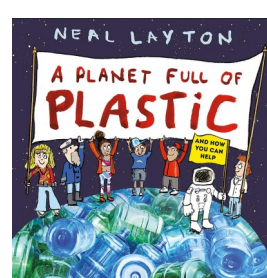

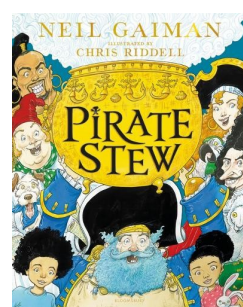
