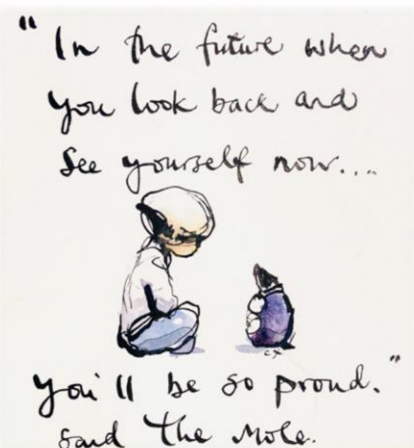
Face Masks

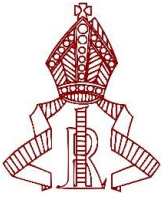

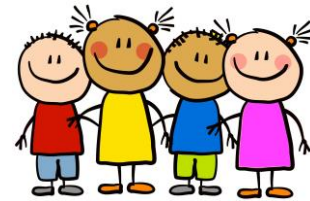
