Year 2 Curriculum Letter – Summer Term – Ms Blacklock

This half term, our Learning Experience is called 'Land Ahoy' and below you can see the learning that will be taking place in different subjects:

English

After exploring a range of pirate themed stories, we will become authors and write our own pirate adventures.

Art

After examining seascapes by different artists, we will create our own using different tones of wool.

Geography

We will be learning the names and locations of the continents and oceans of the world.
We will create pirate maps using symbols and write directions to find the treasure using the 4 compass points.

Music

We will learn about how pirates used sea shanties to help them do jobs on the ship and sing some of our own.

Maths – Properties of Shape

Identify and describe the properties of 2-D shapes, including the number of sides and line symmetry in a vertical line.
Identify and describe the properties of 3-D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces.
Identify 2-D shapes on the surface of 3-D shapes.
Compare and sort common 2-D and 3-D shapes and everyday objects.

Gentle reminders:

- ✓ Please can your child have a water bottle and fruit daily. If it is an apple that your child needs cutting, it would be helpful for that to be done at home.
- ✓ PE happens on a Monday and Thursday, your child will need a PE top, shorts or jogging bottoms and plimsoles/trainers on those days.

Ways to help at home:

- ✓ Please continue to hear your child read regularly, every day, if possible.
- ✓ Practice counting up to 100 from different starting numbers, e.g. 83, 84, 85...99, 100;
- ✓ Practice counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. This could be done whilst they are walking to school, laying the table for dinner, having a bath etc.
