## Year 2/3 Curriculum Letter – Autumn Term – Ms Davies

This half term, our Learning Experience is called ‘Wonderful Me’ and below you can see the learning that will be taking place in the different subjects:

### Literacy

Using the book ‘You Choose’, children will be exploring their likes and dislikes. They will create a double page information spread. All About Me! The main focus is recapping sentence structure; including capital letters, full stops and expanded noun phrases.

### Art

After looking at how Andy Warhol created his Iconic Pop Art, we will be creating our own Pop Art in the style of Andy Warhol. The children will be using complimentary and contrasting blocks of colour.

## Wonderful Me!



### RSHE

What is the same and different about us?

Children will know what makes them special and how everyone has different strengths. Know how their personal features or qualities are unique to them. They will learn about the importance of understanding diversity and gender stereotypes. Within the RSHE topic the children will be learning the scientific names for the male and female parts of the body.

### Science

The children will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, that are dead and that have never been alive.

Following on from that, they will name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

### Maths

Number lines

2-digit and 3-digit place value

Exploring money

Number facts for addition and subtraction

Add/sub using facts and digit patterns

Bridging

Use place value to add and subtract

### Gentle reminders:

- ✓ Please can your child have water bottles and fruit daily. If it's fruit that needs cutting we ask for that to be done at home.
- ✓ PE happens on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday however; your child will need a named school PE kit at school every day. On a Monday, children need to come in wearing their PE kit with their uniform and school shoes in a bag. PE is the first session.
