Year 2/3 Curriculum Letter – Autumn Term 2 – Ms Davies

This half term, we continue with our Explorers and Adventurers Learning experience we started last half term. Towards the beginning of November, we will be moving on to Oh What a Performance which will hopefully culminate with a Christmas Performance at Bishop Luffa School.

Literacy

Using Rocket Mole by Matt Carr, the children will be finding out how to write story starters and looking at how choice of words make a story more exciting. Children will also be carrying on with guided reading as part of their phonics sessions.

DT

Following 'Armstrong' the Mole's fun going to the moon in the book Rocket Mole by Matt Carr, we will be making moon buggies with moving parts for him to explore. We will be considering what materials and ways of joining they can use.

Our RSHE continues from last half term. The children will know what makes them special and how everyone has different strengths. They will know how their personal features or qualities are unique to them and know how they are similar or different to others including what they have in common.

RE

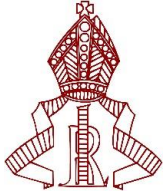
The children will be reflecting why Christmas is important to Christians, That the bible shows us how Jesus was extraordinary as he was worshipped as a king and he came to bring good news to the poor.
Christians celebrate Jesus' birth. That for Christians, Advent is a time for getting ready for Jesus coming.

Gentle reminders:

- ✓ Please can your child have water bottles and fruit daily.
- ✓ Again, many children who come to school with hard fruit such as apples continually request these are cut, please can this be done at home.
- ✓ PE happens on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday however, your child will need a **named** school PE kit at school every day. On a Monday, children need to come in wearing their PE kit with their uniform and school shoes in a bag. PE is the first session.

Ways to help at home:

- ✓ Please encourage your child to read regularly, every day, if possible.
- ✓ Practise their minute a day words.



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- ✓ Year 3's are working on their x tables at their own pace. We have a challenge every Monday. Please help them practice at home.
